Hi Suzanne:

I work at Grants.gov and manage all of our ICs.

DHS reached out to me for advice on “clearing” the RPPR. That set off some alarms in my head since I know that NSF already manages the RPPR, and DHS shouldn’t be clearing anything or creating any a new RPPR IC.

I checked in ROCIS for the RPPR 3145-0221 and saw that RPPR isn’t a Common Form. I figured that it wasn’t a common form in ROCIS since the NOA was from 2015, and the common form concept was introduced in 2016-17.

In the current published FRN, it doesn’t mention anything about seeking classification as a common form. I would assume that it will be a common form since it’s used by more than one agency.

Let me know if NSF plans to make the RPPR a common form. I can pass this info along to DHS. If it’s a common form, then they should be able to do a Request for Common Form in ROCIS and report their own burden hours.
