While I appreciate the effort to clarify and define the terms used, I think it is a mistake to create forms of this length. To go from a 1-page Designation notice to 6 pages and a 2-page Notice of eligibility to 6 pages — that is really unnecessary and it puts a greater burden on employers. From 4 pages to 6 pages for medical forms puts a greater burden on health care providers and they are already charging employees/patients to fill out and fax these forms. As a state agency, we are trying to condense our forms and publications to reduce use of paper. Every request we process requires printing, scanning and faxing of documents — all of which is more costly with additional pages. Please, find ways to tighten up the design of the forms and do whatever you can to reduce the length. A good copy editor and designer could make that work. At 6 pages, these forms are too long.
