In addition: birth interval 18 months or greater from conception to delivery after previous live birth.

I reviewed the forms you shared and for the most part, it contains items that are necessary for the benchmark reporting. I noticed that Lisa Bain also echoed several of my thoughts around the wording and options choices for some of the questions. The one additional comment I had was the capture of birth weight information for child born Very Low Birth Weight or Low Birth Weight. As it stands now, on the PostPartum/Internconceptional Form, question 5 (pg.4) only captures if the baby was less than 5lbs or greater than 9lbs but there is no way to distinguish if the baby was born with VLBW or LBW as I didn't see any place where weight was captured. It might be good to include a question that captures the weight of the baby/babies at birth(s).

I think the addition of this as well as Lisa's suggestion should be sufficient to ensure that you are capturing metrics for both the performance measures and the federal benchmarks.
