Comment on "Information Collections: The Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993, As Amended."

I appreciate the effort to improve the FMLA forms, but I am concerned the new format could result in increased costs for employees. I manage FMLA administration for my employer. We have been receiving feedback from our employees that most medical providers charge a significant fee to complete this paperwork. In some cases, this fee is a per-page charge, and so increasing the number of pages for a provider to complete (even if the new form takes less time) could increase employee costs. I suggest removing white space and making other formatting changes in the final version so there is no change in the number pages for a health care provider to complete.
