<b>Comment:</b>	I oppose this proposed rule. The proposed collection of
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information is not necessary necessary for the proper performance of the functions of the agency. Instead, the collection of information seems to be to identify potentially undocumented immigrants and more broadly, to strike fear in the hearts of all immigrants and their families. I am very concerned about this administrations multi-faceted attack on immigrants. I am a law student studying to be an immigration lawyer, and prior to law school, I worked in immigration law. The election of Donald Trump sent the immigrant communities I worked with into a tailspin of fear. Even green card holders and naturalized citizens felt threatened and felt like there was a core contingent of people in this country who hated them because they were from Mexico. It is clear from the litigation surrounding the citizenship question on the Census that the Trump administration wanted to collect citizenship data to strike fear in the hearts of immigrants and to draw Republican-friendly districts. I believe the motivation for this policy is the same, and I do not believe for one minute that the actual goal is to improve government efficiency or enforce the Voting Rights Act. \*🌐

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
