I have another question with the new implementation of Advance Designation of Representative Payee.

I received the draft forms and Form SSA-4547 states that an individual cannot designate an organization as representative payee.

Since the majority of our clients (98%) are non-verbal and are critical care, will their guardians have to open a **“mySSA Account”** to designate a representative payee, and does this rule also mean that an organization can no longer act as representative payee for a disabled client residing in homes providing care to those disabled clients.
