## General Comment

While I agree that the requirement to collect and submit data of roads already in the NTTFI should be eliminated, I do not agree that this requirement should be enforced when changes or updates to the roads occur. If a road is already inventoried in the NTTFI and it needs to be updated to eliminate pot holes, erosion, or the like, it seems trivial to require data to be collected and submitted for reconsideration if the road should remain in the NTTFI. Furthermore, if a road within the NTTFI is expanded, it is unreasonable to believe that any new data or information would be sufficient to keep the road from remaining in the NTTFI.
