Doctors Hospital at Renaissance (DHR Health) is a homegrown physician-owned community health system developed by local physicians and business leaders. Since our founding over twenty years ago, we have been on a remarkable journey to create a health care renaissance here in the Rio Grande Valley.

We are deeply committed to the Rio Grande Valley because this is our home. We are the only locally owned and operated health system left in Hidalgo and Cameron counties. We serve an area of over 1.3 million people, and provide access to the most comprehensive and specialized high quality health care in one of the poorest regions of the country.

DHR Health is dedicated to addressing all of the health care needs of our community, while eliminating the need for our community to seek medical services outside the region. To that end, DHR Health has invested over \$560 million directly in the Rio Grande Valley, with an additional \$270 million into GME programs. We serve as the flagship teaching hospital for the University Of Texas Rio Grande Valley School Of Medicine with 12 GME programs and 150 residents and fellows.

We continue to invest millions of dollars annually in order to raise the standard of care for our community and bring technology, primary care and specialty services not currently available. We are the region's first and only Level I Comprehensive Trauma Center, and have partnered with Driscoll Children's Hospital to establish the Valley's only non-profit and dedicated charitable children's hospital.

We are an area safety-net hospital, providing over \$400 Million in uncompensated care over the past 10 years, and 70 percent of our overall patient population being covered by Medicaid or Medicare (by discharge). We have served thousands of patients since opening our doors and delivered over 110,000+ babies. Just last year, we birthed an elementary school a month, over 8,000 babies!

Since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, we have been working tirelessly around-the-clock, serving on the front lines so that we can save lives and protect our patients, staff, and community. We have treated over 3,800 COVID-19 patients and are proudly a designated State of Texas Vaccine Hub, having provided over 300,000 vaccinations to date.

We will continue to commit the resources of our entire health system to ensure that none in our community goes without care when needed.
