


Morenci & Safford Operations' Impact on Arizona





Freeport-McMoRan's Morenci and Safford mines generated an estimated \$435.4 million in economic benefits for Greenlee and Graham Counties and approximately \$1.1 billion for Arizona in 2015.

Freeport-McMoRan contributes in many ways to the sustainability of the various communities, counties and states in which we operate. They rely heavily on the economic benefits directly and indirectly provided by our various operations in the form of wages and taxes we pay as well as the goods and services we purchase. This direct spending ripples through the economy, inducing additional economic benefits and contributing to more jobs and greater tax revenues.

The charts to the left explain how the Morenci and Safford mines provide such a boost to the economies of both counties and the state.

At the end of 2015 Freeport-McMoRan had more than 3,100 employees at Morenci and approximately 700 at Safford. Combined the Morenci and Safford mines had a total impact of nearly 10,910 jobs on Arizona's economy.

Freeport-McMoRan generated an estimated \$2.5 billion in economic benefits for Arizona in 2015.




