Dear Secretary Tran:

We ask the Department of Veterans Affairs to cease automatically sending 1099s to Caregivers receiving benefits under the Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers (PCAFC), and to rescind those sent for tax year 2020. These benefits are not taxable, there is no reason for the VA to send a 1099 to these Caregivers, and doing so introduces confusion where none should exist and raises the potential of these benefits erroneously being taxed.

The VA recently posted <u>web-based guidance</u> on the issuance of these 1099s, but did not explain why this is even necessary. Alternatively, <u>VA and the IRS issued guidance</u> states, "VA benefits are not taxable; therefore, VA does not send out 1099 forms. If you need a statement of benefits paid, please contact your VA Regional Office."

We believe the VA should adopt a similar approach for Caregivers – only issuing a 1099 or statement of benefits if requested by the Caregiver or Veteran.

Thank you for your attention to these concerns. The veteran and military serving organizations below stand ready to assist as you consider how best to administer the PCAFC program.
