On the above date, representatives from the Pool & Hot Tub Alliance (PHTA) and the National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) met with the Department of Energy (Department). The purpose of the meeting was to inquire on the status of establishing a Federal regulation for dedicated purpose pool pump motors (DPPPM) that will align with the existing standard for dedicated purpose pool pumps (DPPP) and to provide any additional information the Department may require to move forward. PHTA, NEMA and its members expressed concerns that in order for manufacturers to have adequate time to develop product and to ensure the compliance date is the same as the DPPP rule of July 19, 2021, it was imperative the Department act swiftly. PHTA, NEMA and its members also conveyed to the Department what they believe the consequences of a DPPP rule without a corresponding DPPPM rule would mean to consumers, manufacturers and the public at large.
