AGENCY: Postal Regulatory Commission.

SUMMARY: The Commission's primary responsibility is to ensure the accountability and transparency of the United States Postal Service. Toward that end, the Commission is evaluating its regulations with a goal of improving and streamlining them. To guide this process, the Commission invites comments from the public on its entries in the spring 2013 Unified Agenda of Federal Regulations and Deregulatory Actions.
