and Efficiency (CIGIE) will have under development during the 12 months following publication. The

rulemaking process.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:

In accordance with the Regulatory Flexibility Act, 5 U.S.C. 602, executive agencies are required to

publish in the Federal Register a regulatory flexibility agenda in April and October of each year. Such

regulatory flexibility agenda must include rules that the agency expects to propose or promulgate that are

likely to have a significant economic impact on a substantial number of small entities. CIGIE has

determined, under the Regulatory Flexibility Act, that the regulation under consideration will not have a

significant economic impact on a substantial number of small entities. Moreover, as a result, no

regulatory flexibility analysis is required pursuant to the Regulatory Flexibility Act. Furthermore, the

regulation being considered by CIGIE is not a "significant regulatory action" within the meaning of

Executive Order 12866 entitled "Regulatory Planning and Review" and, therefore, no Regulatory Plan is

required.
