2026 Unified Regulatory Agenda

AGENCY: Social Security Administration.

ACTION: 2026 regulatory agenda.

SUMMARY: We are publishing our 2026 regulatory agenda pursuant to Executive Order 12866, "Regulatory Planning and Review," 58 FR 51735 (1993), with particular adherence to Executive Order 14219, "Efforts to Ensure Lawful Governance and Implement the President's 'Department of Government Efficiency' Deregulatory Initiative," 90 FR 10583 (2025), Executive Order 14192, 'Unleashing Prosperity Through Deregulation,' 90 FR 9065 (2025), and the Regulatory Flexibility Act, 5 U.S.C. sections 601 to 612.
