Unified Agenda of Federal Regulatory and Deregulatory Actions

AGENCY: Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service (FMCS).

ACTION: Update of the Unified Agenda of Federal Regulatory and Deregulatory Actions.

SUMMARY: The Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service (FMCS) is publishing its regulatory agenda pursuant to Executive Order 12866 and the Regulatory Flexibility Act. The regulatory agenda (searchable at www.reginfo.gov) lists all agency regulations that are scheduled for development during the next 12 months or that have been issued since the publication of the previous Agenda. At this time, the Agency does not have any agency regulations that are scheduled for development during the next 12 months or that have been issued since the publication of the previous Agenda.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: Under Executive Order 12866 on Regulatory Planning and Review, each agency is required to prepare an agenda of all regulations under development or review. The Regulatory Flexibility Act, Public Law 98-354, has a similar agenda requirement. Under that law, the agenda must list any regulation that is likely to have a significant economic impact on a substantial number of small entities. The Office of Management and Budget have issued guidelines prescribing the form and content of the regulatory agenda. Under those guidelines, the agenda must list all regulatory activities being conducted or reviewed in the next 12 months and provide certain specified information on each regulation.
